

2023 Impact100 Metro Denver Accelerator Grant Application

Thank you for responding to the *Invitation to Apply* for the Impact100 Accelerator Grant. We are reaching out to a small number of nonprofits in Southwest Denver neighborhoods as defined by the SouthWest Denver Coalition (map is attached for eligible neighborhoods) and look forward to hearing more about the work your nonprofit does in the community.

The Process:

- Consider attending our virtual Q&A Session on January 18, 2023, at 1 p.m. when we will answer any questions you might have about Impact100 or the application. Submit any advance questions to info@impact100metrodenver.org by January 17, 2023, 5 p.m.
- We will review all of the Applications (see below) we have received by the March 3, 2023 deadline.
- From the Applications, we will select some for a site visit so that we can get to know the organization in more depth. If selected for a site visit, further information about that process will be provided.
- After the site visits, 3 finalists will be selected to move forward for a vote of the entire Impact100 Metro Denver membership to select the \$25,000 Grantee Awardee. The other two finalists will receive a \$500 award. The 3 finalists will be notified and given further information at that time.
- The vote will be held in early June and the final Grantee will be notified. The Grantee will be announced to the public at our Awards event on June 7, 2023.
- Funding will be provided to the Grantee in July 2023.
- Impact100 members are willing to provide volunteer support as may be appropriate and desired by the selected Grantee.
- The communication process between the Grantee and Impact100 will be mutually developed at the beginning of the Grant cycle.
