Impact Grants Committee

- The Impact Grants Committee annually decides upon and awards over \$200,000 in grants to area non-profits. This is our largest grant making committee. After releasing a Request for Proposal (RFP) in late fall, we evaluate the applications, individually and as a committee, and recommend three finalists to our full Impact100 membership, who then vote for the annual grant award recipients. Annually we seek new members to be part of the analysis, committee deliberations, and site visit teams, which lasts from January thru April.

Accelerator Grant Committee

- This committee oversees our smaller 3-year grant. The next grant cycle for the Accelerator Grant is 2029–2031, with Committee work beginning in mid-2028. We research community challenges, recommend the focus area for the Accelerator Grant, and conduct outreach to eligible nonprofit organizations. Committee members interview prospective applicants, review findings, and narrow the candidates for financial review. The full Committee then votes to recommend a finalist to all Impact100 members prior to the Annual Luncheon. Committee co-chairs anticipate recruiting at least 20 Committee members.
